Milwaukee School of Engineering (MSOE) is proud to partner with *FIRST* (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) to offer scholarships to students who have participated on a FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) team or FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) team.

Scholarship Information

Any MSOE student who participated in *FIRST* and completes the application will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Also, two *FIRST* participants will be awarded an additional \$4,000 scholarship.

To be eligible, students must apply and be admitted as a full-time incoming freshman and have participated in *FIRST* any time during high school. This scholarship may be utilized for any undergraduate course of study at MSOE. This scholarship is renewable up to four years if the student maintains a MSOE minimum grade point average of 2.25 on a 4.00 scale.
