Scholarship Information

Any MSOE student who participated in the SMART Team program will receive a \$1,000 Scholarship.

To be eligible, students must apply and be admitted as a full-time incoming freshman and have participated in the Center for BioMolecular Modeling SMART Team program any time during high school. This scholarship may be utilized for any undergraduate course of study at MSOE. This scholarship is renewable up to four years if the student maintains a MSOE minimum grade point average of 2.25 on a 4.00.

- A 500 word essay regarding your SMART experience and your career goals , as well as why you would like to attend MSOE
- A letter of recommendation from an adult SMART Team Teacher or Mentor
